# SEAPORT SAILING SCHOOL

Seaport Sailing School Classes will be held at Tuckerton Seaport, a recreated maritime village, on the Tuckerton Creek and Little Egg Bay.

Tuckerton was one of the original ports of entry for the colonial east coast. Steeped in history and ideally located on the Tuckerton Creek, which leads out to the Little Egg Bay, Tuckerton is a natural location for a sailing school.

The Seaport Sailing School is currently accepting registration for basic keelboat sailing and basic coastal cruising instruction. Students successfully completing either class will earn an A.S.A sailing certification and a National Safe Boating Certificate approved by the NASBLA (National Association of State Boating Law Administrators) and the U.S. Coast Guard.

Classes are held weekends beginning in April and will continue through October.

## ASA 101: BASIC KEELBOAT SAILING CERTIFICATION

*A two day course for the beginner. In this course you will get hands-on experience in the fundamentals of safety, sail handling, sailing upwind and down, man overboard, anchoring, docking and leaving the dock on a boat of 20 feet or more.*

This introduction to sailing is designed to give the beginner the skills and confidence to sail a 22 to 24 foot boat. Instruction includes:

- Nautical nomenclature
- Rules of the road
- Points of sail
- Proper tacking procedure
- Rigging
- Sail trim
- Ground tackle
- Proper radio procedures
- Safety afloat
- Navigation

Successful candidates will be issued ASA certification and National Safe Boating Certificate approved by the NASBLA and the USCG.

## ASA 103: BASIC COASTAL CRUISING CERTIFICATION

*(PREREQUISITE: ASA 101-BASIC KEELBOAT)*

*A two day course for those wishing to become more familiar with cruising and cruising boats. This course pays particular attention to docking and maneuvering the cruising sailboat with an inboard engine. It will also cover safety, rules of the road, boat systems, navigation, weather and cruise planning, as well as other subjects that will help ensure a safe and successful cruise. Held on a boat 27 feet or larger.*

This more advanced course is designed to turn the confident keelboat sailor into a competent skipper capable of handling a 30 foot sailboat in coastal waters. Instruction includes:

- Boat handling
- Seamanship
- Reefing
- Weather
- Advanced navigation
